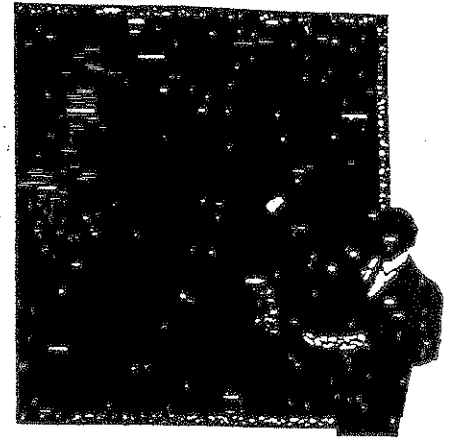

Once again Vedder Golden Branch is prepared to offer financial assistance, in the form of bursaries, to those students who are graduating from Sardis Secondary School and who wish to further their education at an accredited University, College, Technical School, Hospital Schools of Nursing or other institutions that require graduation from a Senior Secondary School as a pre-requisite.

These bursaries will be awarded to qualified students who have "good potential" for the training required, who have not reached the age of 26 years at the time of graduation from Secondary School, shows financial need and present proof of acceptance for enrollment in a full time career course at a qualifying institution

This year Vedder Golden Branch will be offering five (5) bursaries in the amount of \$500.00 each, as follows:

Three (3) bursaries will be offered from: the Branch General Fund (Open to all graduating students);

Two (2) bursaries will be awarded from the Poppy Trust Fund (open to dependent children and grandchildren of deceased, disabled, or other veterans and service personnel).

Fully completed application forms are to be received by the Branch Bursary Committee by ~~May 1st 2001~~

It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to fully and properly complete the application form and to ensure that all related items are submitted by the deadline date. Incomplete, or late, applications will not be considered, nor will any follow-up be done.

Successful applicants will receive a Certificate showing that they have been awarded a bursary and the amount of the bursary will be paid to the institute at which the student has been accepted.
