The Public Service Alliance of Canada each year offers four \$1000 scholarships and twelve \$300 bursaries – one to a student in each province and territories - on the basis of financial need and scholastic achievement and a 500-750 word essay on one of the topics outlined below. One of the \$1,000 scholarships is being offered in recognition of April 28 – The Day of Mourning

ELIGIBILITY: Sons and daughters of PSAC members in good standing are June 30 of the calendar year who are *leaving high school and entering their FIRST year* of university, college, or institute of higher learning are eligible to apply. (Children of PSAC employees or members of the National Board of Directors are not eligible).

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must attend a university or recognized standing or a recognized institute of higher learning on a full-time basis.
- With reference to the financial need basis, please explain your circumstances on the attached sheet.
- A 500-750 word essay on one of the following topics:
 - a) Why I believe the work that my Mother/Father does is important to Canadians;
 - b) Labour's contributions to the community;
 - c) What you foresee as the role of organized labour in the future;
 - d) The importance of employers making workplaces healthier and safer; OR
 - e) How we can clean up the environment to make it a healthier place to live.

(The last two essays are in recognition of the Day of Mourning)

PROOF OF REGISTRATION: Proof of registration and/or the name of the university or recognized institute of higher learning you will be attending must be submitted with your application. Attendance will be verified before the granting of the award.

NOTE: The PSAC reserves the right to withhold granting of the award if no applicant is deemed to possess the necessary requirements, or for other valid reasons.
