Grade 11 Early Application

- Benefits:
 - Guaranteed admission upon graduation with the successful completion of prerequisites
 - Students are a part of the academic community
 - Invitation to special events and activities
 - Direct access to science professors and advisors
 - Meet other students who will be in the program
 - Relevant work experience hours

Who Should Apply?

- Students in Grade 11 who have a strong interest in science
- Students who think they may pursue a career in science
- Students need only to have average marks
- Be willing to meet the mark and course prerequisites upon graduation
 - Eng 12
 - PMA 12 with a "B"
 - 1 Grade 12 Science with a "C+" *

How to Apply

- Apply between Oct 1 and Jan 31st in Grade 11
- Students will apply using UFV application
- Students will be assisted through the process by Science Advice
 - Karen Cooper at scienceadvice@ufv.ca
 - Self report grade 11 marks in March

Concurrent Studies

- Courses can count as “dual credit” earning both university credits and secondary credits
- Available to academically strong grade 11 and 12 students
- Recommended as a 9th course, taken after school
- Excellent opportunity for subject-focused students
- Students are in fully integrated courses at university
- Students accumulate university credits which ladder to UFV and are widely transferable

How to Apply

- Students select course(s) which have no prerequisite or prerequisite has already been satisfied
- May apply to fall, winter and condensed summer sessions
- Students apply May 31 for summer and fall semesters and Nov 30 for winter semester. Earlier is better!
- Submit UFV application with \$45.00 app fee, request for Concurrent Studies, current transcript, parent permission and school recommendation

Get Started Early in Trades Regional Career Programming (RCP)

- RCP is in addition to school district programs
- Students are still enrolled in home high school
- UFV courses may qualify for dual credit
- Start UFV full time in last year of high school
- Students can graduate with Dogwood and Trades certificate

- Aircraft Structures are offered at the UFV Aerospace
Centre located at the Abbotsford Airport
- Students should have reliable transportation

Who Should Apply?

- Students interested in programs not available in your district
- Students wanting a career in trades
- Students who have completed core high school courses
- Students eager to get a head start in their career

How to Apply

- Apply before November 30th in Grade 11 for preferred seating
- Submit completed RCP application package and \$45 application fee
- School Counsellors send application to Karen Massier at UFV
- Take program specific entrance tests
